

RENTAL CONTRACT.

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This Agreement, Made and entered into this 27th day of February 1907 by and between John Crossland of the Cherokee Company of the first part, and party of the second part.

Witnesseth, That for and in consideration of the covenants and agreements hereinafter made by the part of the second part, the part of the first part has this day resented unto the this day and by these presents do demise and let to the part of the second part its executors, heirs and assigns, for agricultural purposes, for the term of Five years from the 27th day of February 1907 the following described parcels of land: Farm or parcel of Land to wit N 21 1/4 of Sec 14 and S 1/2 of N 1/4 of Sec 14 of Township N., Range E. and N 1/4 of Sec 14 of S 1/2 of N 1/4 of Sec 14 of Township N., Range E. Thirtieth and 32 Township Twenty (20) of Section Township N., Range E. north Range forested (14) east of Section Township N., Range E. containing several acres more or less. It is understood and agreed that the part of the second part will pay said part of the first part a rental of \$ per annum during the term of this contract, payable as follows:

for term, five \$1000 per annum as follows. To be paid on August 1st of each year and after possession is given to the party of the second part the said party of the second part agree to build a good two room box house and dig a well on said place and to enclose all of said land under a three wire fence and to place said improvements on said land before the expiration of this contract.
