

RENTAL CONTRACT.

This Agreement, Made and entered into this 11th day of August 1906 by and between

Witnesseth, That for and in consideration of the covenants and agreements hereinafter made by the part 2nd of the second part, the
part 1st of the first part this day and by these presents
do demise and let to the part 2nd of the second part his heirs and assigns, for Pasture
purposes, for the term of
5 years from the 1st day of January 1917 the following
described parcels of land:

of Section Township N., Range E

It is understood and agreed that the part 2nd of the second part will pay said part 1st of the first part a rental of \$ 10.00
per annum during the term of this
contract, payable as follows:
