**Witnesseth**, That for and in consideration of the covenants and agreements hereinafter made by the part y of the second part, the

do demise and let to the part y of the second part lives heirs and assigns, for Agricultural purposes, for the term of  
Five years from the 1st day of January, 1908, the following  
described parcels of land: Indian Land,
