

RENTAL CONTRACT.

This Agreement, Made and entered into this 15 day of May 1907 by and between
Lasley Haynes of Broken Arrow Ind. Terr
 of J. E. Lucas part 4 of the first part, and
 party of the second part.

Witnesseth, That for and in consideration of the covenants and agreements hereinafter made by the part 4 of the second part, the
 part 4 of the first part, this day and by these presents
 do demise and let to the part 4 of the second part his heirs and assigns, for agricultural
purposes for the term of
three years from the first day of January 1908 the following
 described parcels of land:

The north west quarter of Section 21 Township 18 N., Range 14 E.
 of Section Township N., Range E.
 of Section Township N., Range E.
 of Section Township N., Range E.

It is understood and agreed that the part 4 of the second part will pay said part 4 of the first part a rental of \$ 25.00
 per annum during the term of this
 contract payable as follows:

Fifty dollars each year to be invested in
buildings and repairs
and two hundred dollars payable on the
first day of January of each year commencing
Jan 1, 1915

It is understood and agreed that any hog fence put upon
 the premises by the party of the second part may be
 removed by the said second party at the expiration of
 this lease
