WARRANTY DEED

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That we, Will Moore and Lee Moore
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of One DOLLARS

and other good and valuable considerations the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto said George W. Adams and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following lands lying in the Creek Nation Western District of the Indian Territory, to wit:

the north 1/2 of the south west 1/4 of section 14, 8 and the south east 1/4 of north west 1/4 of section 27, all in township 10, north Range 12, east also north east 1/4 of north east 1/4 of Sec 23, Township 19 north Range 12 east containing 160 acres more or less

To have and to hold the same unto the said George W. Adams and unto his heirs and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said George W. Adams that I will forever warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Lee Moore, wife of the said Will Moore for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said George W. Adams all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
