WARRANTY DEED

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That Lewis M. Poe and
 his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of One dollar DOLLARS,
to me in hand paid by Mrs. Lou Poe, the receipt of which is hereby
acknowledged, and in consideration of the love and affection for her as my wife, do hereby grant,
 bargain, sell and convey unto said Mrs. Lou Poe and unto her heirs and assigns forever, the following

lands lying in the City of Tulsa Western District of the Indian Territory, to wit:
all of lots numbered four (4) and five (5), in Block number one hundred
sixty four (164) in the City of Tulsa, as shown by the Government
plat of said Town approved by the Secretary of the Interior.

To have and to hold the same unto the said Mrs. Lou Poe and unto her heirs and as-
 signs forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Mrs. Lou Poe that I will forever warrant and defend the
 title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Lewis M. Poe, wife of the said Lewis M. Poe for and in consideration of the said sum of
 money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Mrs. Lou Poe all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
