To have and to hold the same unto the said R. R. Roberts and unto his heirs and as-
 signs forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant o with said R. R. Roberts that they will forever warrant and defend the
 title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Jennie Farsy the, wife of the said Jay Farsy the for and in consideration of the said sum of
 money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said R. R. Roberts all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
