

WARRANTY DEED

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That we, R. E. Lynch and Y. L. Lynch
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Three Hundred & Fifty DOLLARS,
the receipt of the same being hereby acknowledged
and to us in hand paid by L. C. Brown do hereby grant,
bargain, sell and convey unto said L. C. Brown and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following

lands lying in the Creek nation Western District of the Indian Territory, to wit:
Lot one (1) of section nine (9), Township sixteen
(19) north Range twelve (12) east of the Indian
meridian and containing eight (8) and 9/10
acres more or less

To have and to hold the same unto the said L. C. Brown and unto his heirs and as-
signs forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said L. C. Brown that they will forever warrant and defend the
title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Y. L. Lynch, wife of the said R. E. Lynch for and in consideration of the said sum of
money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said L. C. Brown all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
