WARRANTY DEED

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That we John A. Mitchell and Alice M. Mitchell
 his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Five Hundred Fifty and no/100 DOLLARS,
to us in hand paid by J. F. Meeling, the receipt of which is hereby
acknowledged do hereby grant,

bargain, sell and convey unto said J. F. Meeling and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following
 lands lying in the Town of West Tulsa, Creek Nation Western District of the Indian Territory, to wit:

all of the same being Section (13) and Section (14), Block numbered Twenty (20), situated
in West Tulsa, Creek Nation, Indian Territory, according to the record first stated

To have and to hold the same unto the said J. F. Meeling and unto his heirs and as-
 signs forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

I put myself and deed myself with said J. F. Meeling that we will forever warrant and defend the
 And hereby covenant with said J. F. Meeling title of said lands against all claims whatever persons claiming the same by and through me,

And I, Alice M. Mitchell, wife of the said John A. Mitchell for and in consideration of the said sum of
 money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said J. F. Meeling all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
