do hereby grant,
 bargain, sell and convey unto said A. W. Wilhite and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following
 lands lying in the Creek Nation Western District of the Indian Territory, to wit:
Lot (15) Fifteenth Block (12) Twelve Lynch & Fargy the
Adoption Co. Survey, Ind. Ter.

To have and to hold the same unto the said A. W. Wilhite and unto his heirs and as-
 signs forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant ed with said A. W. Wilhite that they will forever warrant and defend the
 title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Jennie Fargy the, wife of the said Jay Fargy the for and in consideration of the said sum of
 money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said A. W. Wilhite all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
