WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

do hereby grant,
 bargain, sell and convey unto said Frank R. Gillespie and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following
 lands lying in the North Tular Western District of the Indian Territory, to wit:

all of Lot Six (6) in Block Eight (8) in north Tular in the city of
Tulsa, Ind. Ter., according to the recorded plat thereof, the same
lot having a frontage of 95 feet facing on Archer Ave.

To have and to hold the same unto the said Frank R. Gillespie and unto his heirs and as-
 signs forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant I with said Frank R. Gillespie that I will forever warrant and defend the
 title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Annie C. Archer, ~~wife of the said~~ single for and in consideration of the said sum of
 money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Frank R. Gillespie all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
