 signs forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant _____ with said _____ that _____ will forever warrant and defend the
 title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, _____, wife of the said _____ for and in consideration of the said sum of
 money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said _____ all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
