## WARRANTY DEED

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That we H. Herbert L. Feigly and a single unmarried man,  
 his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Twenty five and 00/100 DOLLARS,  
 to him paid cash in hand, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged  
 as paid by Al R. Feigly of Shitook, I.T. do hereby grant,  
 bargain, sell and convey unto said Al R. Feigly and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following  
 lands lying in the Cherokee Nation Western District of the Indian Territory, to wit:  
All of Lot number ten (10), in Block number four-teen (14), in  
Shitook, Ind. Ter., according to the original plat as per record,

To have and to hold the same unto the said Al R. Feigly and unto his heirs and as-  
 signs forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Al R. Feigly that he will forever warrant and defend the  
 title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, \_\_\_\_\_, wife of the said \_\_\_\_\_ for and in consideration of the said sum of  
 money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said \_\_\_\_\_ all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
