WARRANTY DEED

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That we, Frank D. Marquis and Fannie Marquis
 his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of five hundred noles DOLLARS,
the receipt of the same being hereby acknowledged and to us in
hand paid Jake Hachaw do hereby grant,
 bargain, sell and convey unto said Jake Hachaw and unto their heirs and assigns forever, the following
 lands lying in the Range 10, Road 1st to 1st Western District of the Indian Territory, to wit:

Lot 10 (2) Block 10 (11) and according to the "Plot and
Survey of the Lynch & Fanny the Addition to Iowa, A. I.

To have and to hold the same unto the said Jake Hachaw and unto his heirs and as-
 signs forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Jake Hachaw that they will forever warrant and defend the
 title of said lands against all claims whatever.

Except a certain mortgage for \$200 & due the Farmers National Bank Iowa, I. I.
 And I, Fannie Marquis, wife of the said Frank D. Marquis for and in consideration of the said sum of
 money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Jake Hachaw all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
