WARRANTY DEED

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That we Floyd Corlett and Minnie E. Corlett
 his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Two Thousand and 00/100 DOLLARS,
to us in hand paid by Alva T. Fountain, the receipt whereof is hereby
acknowledged do hereby grant,
 bargain, sell and convey unto said Alva T. Fountain and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following

lands lying in the City of Tulsa Western District of the Indian Territory, to wit:

Lot Two (112) Block Nine (9) in "Lindsey's second addition" to
the said City of Tulsa, according to the duly certified plat of said
addition

To have and to hold the same unto the said Alva T. Fountain and unto his heirs and as-
 signs forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Alva T. Fountain that we will forever warrant and defend the
 title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Minnie E. Corlett, wife of the said Floyd Corlett for and in consideration of the said sum of
 money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Alva T. Fountain all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
