WARRANTY DEED

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That we Nirama A. Thompson and Laura E. Thompson
 his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Three Thousand (\$3,000.00) DOLLARS,

do hereby grant,
 bargain, sell and convey unto said Frank C. Cheley and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following
 lands lying in the Town of Tulsa Western District of the Indian Territory, to wit:
West Half (W 1/2) of Lot Five (5) in Block One Hundred Thirty -
Three (133) in the Town of Tulsa, Ind. Ter.

To have and to hold the same unto the said Frank C. Cheley and unto his heirs and as-
 signs forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Frank C. Cheley that we will forever warrant and defend the
 title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Laura E. Thompson, wife of the said Nirama A. Thompson for and in consideration of the said sum of
 money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Frank C. Cheley all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
