WARRANTY DEED

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS,

do hereby grant,
bargain, sell and convey unto said Frank Chesley and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following
lands lying in the Town of Tulsa, Western District of the Indian Territory, to wit:
West Half (W 1/2), Lot 133 (6) in Block One Hundred Thirty Three
(133) in the town of Tulsa, Ind. Ter.

To have and to hold the same unto the said Frank Chesley and unto his heirs and as-
signs forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Frank Chesley that we will forever warrant and defend the
title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Wiram A. Thompson husband of the said Laura E. Thompson for and in consideration of the said sum of
money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Frank Chesley ^{my country} all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
