WARRANTY DEED

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That we, Maurice a DeVina and Etta M. DeVina, his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Two Hundred DOLLARS, in land paid by D E Morris receipt of which is hereby acknowledged and confessed do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto said D E Morris and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following lands lying in the City of Tulsa Western District of the Indian Territory, to wit:

Lot four (4) Block four (4) in Brady Heights addition to the city of Tulsa Indian Territory according to the recorded plat thereof

To have and to hold the same unto the said D E Morris and unto his heirs and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said D E Morris that we will forever warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Etta M. DeVina, wife of the said Maurice a DeVina for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said D E Morris all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
