WARRANTY DEED

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That we J. T. Montgomery and Louise Montgomery
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Six Hundred DOLLARS,
to me in hand paid by B. T. Earle and H. B. Carlisle

do hereby grant,
bargain, sell and convey unto said B. T. Earle and H. B. Carlisle and unto their heirs and assigns forever, the following
lands lying in the Creek Nation Western District of the Indian Territory, to wit:

all our right title and interest in Lot 3 Block one
hundred and eighty five in the town of Tulsa Indian
Territory

To have and to hold the same unto the said B. T. Earle and H. B. Carlisle and unto their heirs and as-
signs forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said B. T. Earle and H. B. Carlisle that we will forever warrant and defend the
title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Louise Montgomery wife of the said J. T. Montgomery for and in consideration of the said sum of
money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said B. T. Earle and H. B. Carlisle all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
