KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

to us in hand paid by J.B. Wright the receipt
of which is hereby acknowledged do hereby grant,
bargain, sell and convey unto said J.B. Wright and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following

lands lying in the City of Tulsa Western District of the Indian Territory, to wit:

Lot numbered five (5) in Block numbered
two hundred two (202) in the City of Tulsa
as the same appears on the official
plat of said town

To have and to hold the same unto the said J.B. Wright and unto his heirs and as-
signs forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said J.B. Wright that we will forever warrant and defend the
title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, _____, wife of the said _____ for and in consideration of the said sum of
money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said _____ all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
