WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That we, Jesse Huffman and Mary E. Huffman his wife
 his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of One thousand DOLLARS,
 to us in hand paid by J.B. Wright the receipt
 of which is hereby confessed and acknowledged, do hereby grant,
 bargain, sell and convey unto said J.B. Wright and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following
 lands lying in the City of Tulsa Western District of the Indian Territory, to wit:

all of lot numbered four and part of lot
numbered Three in Block numbered two
hundred Two (2) described as all of lot number
four in Block numbered two hundred Two (2) and that
part of lot numbered three in Block numbered two
hundred Two (2) which is bounded on the north by
lot numbered four in Block numbered two hundred
Two (2) and on the south by lot numbered one
hundred Two (2) and on the east by lot numbered
three in Block numbered two hundred Two (2) and
on the west by lot numbered four in Block
numbered two hundred Two (2) with a minimum
width of fifty feet according to the official plat of said
block.

 title of said lands against all claims whatever.
