WARRANTY DEED

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That we H. A. Earns and Myrtle A. Earns
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Four Hundred (\$400) DOLLARS,

do hereby grant,
bargain, sell and convey unto said W. A. Fleming and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following
lands lying in the Earns addition to the Town of Tulsa Western District of the Indian Territory, to wit:

all of Lot four in Block two (L & B Co) in
Earns addition to Tulsa Indian Territory
according to the recorded plat thereof.

To have and to hold the same unto the said W. A. Fleming and unto his heirs and as-
signs forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said W. A. Fleming that they will forever warrant and defend the
title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Myrtle A. Earns, wife of the said H. A. Earns for and in consideration of the said sum of
money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said W. A. Fleming all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
