WARRANTY DEED

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That we A. B. Campbell and M. M. Campbell
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of One Thousand DOLLARS,
to them in hand paid by Henry C. Brockman the receipt whereof
is hereby confessed and acknowledged do hereby grant,
bargain, sell and convey unto said Henry C. Brockman and unto her heirs and assigns forever, the following
lands lying in the Town of Tulsa Western District of the Indian Territory, to wit:

The south 39.5 feet of Lot numbered three and the north 10.5 feet
of Lot numbered four all in Block numbered six of the Third &
Eighty addition to Tulsa, I. T. according to the recorded plat
thereof.

To have and to hold the same unto the said Henry C. Brockman and unto her heirs and as-
signs forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Henry C. Brockman that they will forever warrant and defend the
title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, M. M. Campbell, wife of the said A. B. Campbell for and in consideration of the said sum of
money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Henry C. Brockman all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
