## WARRANTY DEED

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That we, A. B. Campbell and M. M. Campbell  
 his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of One Thousand (\$1000) DOLLARS,  
The receipt of which is hereby acknowledged,

do hereby grant,  
 bargain, sell and convey unto said W. G. Brockman and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following  
 lands lying in the City of Tulsa Western District of the Indian Territory, to wit:

The South Fifty (50) feet of lot 7 (acres) in Block six (6)  
in Tract & Subletted addition to the City of Tulsa, Indian Territory  
according to the recorded plat thereof.

To have and to hold the same unto the said W. G. Brockman and unto his heirs and as-  
 signs forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said W. G. Brockman that we will forever warrant and defend the  
 title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, M. M. Campbell, wife of the said A. B. Campbell for and in consideration of the said sum of  
 money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said W. G. Brockman all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
