WARRANTY DEED

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That we Maurice A. De Vries and Etta M. De Vries
 his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Four Hundred DOLLARS,
Receipt of which is hereby acknowledged

do hereby grant,
 bargain, sell and convey unto said Rachel M. Chestain and unto her heirs and assigns forever, the following
 lands lying in the Cherokee Nation Western District of the Indian Territory, to wit:

Lot seven (7) in Block (5) in Brady Heights addition to the City
of Tulsa, Oklahoma, according to the official plat thereof, recorded in the
clerk's office at Claremore, I. T.

To have and to hold the same unto the said Rachel M. Chestain and unto her heirs and as-
 signs forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Rachel M. Chestain that we will forever warrant and defend the
 title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Etta M. De Vries, wife of the said Maurice A. De Vries for and in consideration of the said sum of
 money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Rachel M. Chestain all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
