## WARRANTY DEED

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That we, Mary Kelley and my wife Mitchell, do hereby grant, to her in land paid by J. H. Leavitt, of Brewster, N.Y., receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto said J. H. Leavitt, and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following lands lying in the Western District of the Indian Territory, to wit:

The first half of the Southeast Quarter and the North East Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of section nine (9) Township Marcellus (19) North, Range Thirteen (13) East.

To have and to hold the same unto the said J. H. Leavitt and unto his heirs and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said J. H. Leavitt his and assigns that we will forever warrant and defend the title to said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Mary Kelley wife of the said J. H. Leavitt, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said J. H. Leavitt all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
