# WARRANTY DEED

lands lying in the Town of Chelsea Western District of the Indian Territory, to wit: Lot One (1) in Block  
Twenty four (24) except the southerly five (5) feet of said lot described  
as follows: - Beginning at the south easterly corner of said Lot (1),  
thence northerly along the westerly line of said block 3 feet, thence west-  
erly along the parallel 40 feet, thence northerly from the southerly  
line of said lot 100 feet, thence easterly along the southerly line of said lot 1,000  
feet, thence north easterly along the southerly line of said lot 1,000  
feet to place of beginning. This deed is made to correct  
an error in the description in a warranty deed dated July 17, 1905 made by grantors  
to have and to hold the same unto the said Edmond Vaden and unto his heirs and as-

signs forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Edmond Vaden that we will forever warrant and defend the  
title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Marie E. Starr, wife of the said Orris F. Starr for and in consideration of the said sum of  
money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
