WARRANTY DEED

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That we George R. Adams and Ollie J. Adams,
 his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of One DOLLAR,
and other good and valuable considerations in hand paid by George W. Adams, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged,
 do hereby grant,
 bargain, sell and convey unto said George W. Adams and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following

lands lying in the Western District of the Indian Territory, to wit:

Lot 3 in Block 67, in the Town of Tulsa, Indian Territory
according to the official survey.

To have and to hold the same unto the said George W. Adams and unto his heirs and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said George W. Adams that we will forever warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Ollie J. Adams, wife of the said George R. Adams for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said George W. Adams all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
