## WARRANTY DEED

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That we Ella Harner and W. M. Harner, wife and husband  
 his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Five Hundred DOLLARS,  
to them in hand paid by F. M. Radolf, the receipt whereof is hereby  
conferred, and acknowledged do hereby grant,  
 bargain, sell and convey unto said F. M. Radolf and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following  
 lands lying in the County of Indian Western District of the Indian Territory, to wit:  
Lot number Eleven of Block numbered Two of The Harner addition to Tulsa  
I. T. according to the amended plat thereof, same being of record.

To have and to hold the same unto the said F. M. Radolf and unto his heirs and as-  
 signs forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said F. M. Radolf that they will forever warrant and defend the  
 title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Ella Harner, wife of the said W. M. Harner for and in consideration of the said sum of  
 money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said F. M. Radolf all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
