WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

to us paid by R. L. DeWitt

do hereby grant,  
 bargain, sell and convey unto said R. L. DeWitt and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following  
 lands lying in the NE 1/4 of the NW 1/4 and the west half shown on the  
US Survey as Lots 1 & 2 of the NW 1/4 of Sec  
31 T. 19 N., and Range 14 E, Creek Nation  
Western District of the Indian Territory  
to wit: Lot 18 Northwesten Block 29 in Township  
same in Valley ET

To have and to hold the same unto the said R. L. DeWitt and unto his heirs and as-  
 signs forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said R. L. DeWitt that we will forever warrant and defend the  
 title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Bessie L. Williams wife of the said S. K. Williams for and in consideration of the said sum of  
 money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said R. L. DeWitt all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
