H. Leavitt of Coweta, I.T. receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant, and to the said J. H. Leavitt and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following

lands lying in the Western District of the Indian Territory, to wit:

The allotment of Ruben and Mary Kelly, section 17, township 19 N., Range 12 East and the allotment of Mary Kelly being the Northwest quarter of the Northwest quarter and lots six (6) and seven (7) of section 8 and lots 11 (C) and the Southwest quarter of the Southwest quarter of section nine (9) all in Township 19 N., Range 12 East.

To have and to hold the same unto the said J. H. Leavitt and unto his heirs and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said J. H. Leavitt his heirs and assigns, that we will forever warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Nancy Barnett, wife of the said Daniel Barnett, for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said J. H. Leavitt his heirs and assigns all right of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
