KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That we, Mrs. Bird B. Carle and H. V. Carle, her husband
 his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Two Hundred and fifty (\$250) DOLLARS,
cash in hand paid the receipt of which is hereby
acknowledged do hereby grant,
 bargain, sell and convey unto said L. W. Lindsey and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following
 lands lying in the Town of Tulsa Western District of the Indian Territory, to wit:

Lot Ten (10) in Block eight (8) in Lindsey's
First Addition to the City of Tulsa Second Series.

To have and to hold the same unto the said L. W. Lindsey and unto his heirs and as-
 signs forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said L. W. Lindsey that we will forever warrant and defend the
 title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, H. V. Carle husband Mrs. Bird B. Carle wife of the said H. V. Carle for and in consideration of the said sum of
 money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said L. W. Lindsey all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
