WARRANTY DEED

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That we Stephen H. Corey and Sarah Corey
 his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of ten hundred DOLLARS,
land said in Mina B. Hudson's deed of which
she has acknowledged and confessed do hereby grant,
 bargain, sell and convey unto said Mina B. Hudson and unto her heirs and assigns forever, the following
 lands lying in the City of Tulsa Western District of the Indian Territory, to wit:

North half N 1/2 of Lot 216 in Block
One Hundred and fifty one (151) being 50 feet
front and 140 feet deep in Tulsa D. according to
the record plat thereof

To have and to hold the same unto the said Mina B. Hudson and unto her heirs and as-
 signs forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Mina B. Hudson that we will forever warrant and defend the
 title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Sarah H. Corey, wife of the said Stephen H. Corey for and in consideration of the said sum of
 money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Mina B. Hudson all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
