WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That we Lila D Lindsey and L W Lindsey
 her husband
 his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Seventeen Hundred DOLLARS,
The receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged

do hereby grant,
 bargain, sell and convey unto said A B Rainier and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following
 lands lying in the Town of Tulsa Western District of the Indian Territory, to wit:

The town lots numbered five (5) six (6) seven
(7) and eight (8) in Lindsey Second addition
as per plat thereof executed by J Gus Patton

To have and to hold the same unto the said A B Rainier and unto his heirs and as-
 signs forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said A B Rainier that we will forever warrant and defend the
 title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, L W Lindsey husband Lila D Lindsey wife of the said L W Lindsey for and in consideration of the said sum of
 money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said A B Rainier all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
