WARRANTY DEED

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we, Low R. Stansbury and Mary C. Stansbury
John N. Day and Watherine M. Day
 his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Forteen Hundred DOLLARS,

in hand paid by Ira Jane M. Kenzie and Joshua F. M. Kenzie, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto said Ira Jane M. Kenzie and unto their heirs and assigns forever, the following lands lying in the City of Tulsa, Western District of the Indian Territory, to wit:

lots one two and three (1-2-3) in Block six (6) in Stansbury addition to the City of Tulsa Indian Territory according to the recorded plat thereof

To have and to hold the same unto the said Ira Jane M. Kenzie and Joshua F. M. Kenzie and unto their heirs and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Ira Jane M. Kenzie and Joshua F. M. Kenzie that we will forever warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

we Mary C. Stansbury and Low R. Stansbury and Watherine M. Day for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Ira Jane M. Kenzie all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
