WARRANTY DEED

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That we Rosetta Presley and
 his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Eighteen Hundred \$800 DOLLARS,
on hand paid the receipt of which is hereby
acknowledged do hereby grant,
 bargain, sell and convey unto said Mary M. Barber and unto her heirs and assigns forever, the following
 lands lying in the Creek nation Western District of the Indian Territory, to wit:

The north half of the south east quarter of Section
One (1) Township eighteen (18) north Range fourteen (14)
east and the south west quarter of the south east
quarter of Section One (1) Township eighteen (18) north
Range fourteen (14) east containing one hundred twenty
acres more or less.

To have and to hold the same unto the said Mary M. Barber and unto her heirs and as-
 signs forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Mary M. Barber that she will forever warrant and defend the
 title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Rosetta Presley, wife of the said Mary M. Barber for and in consideration of the said sum of
 money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Mary M. Barber all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
