To have and to hold the same unto the said Charlie W. Eaton and unto his heirs and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Charlie W. Eaton that he will forever warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Stephan P. Lewis, wife of the said Stephen P. Lewis, for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Stephen P. Lewis all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
