on hand, paid by Charlie W Eaton receipt of same being hereby acknowledged. do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto said Charlie W Eaton and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following

lands lying in the Creek Nation Western District of the Indian Territory, to wit: an undivided one fourth $\frac{1}{4}$ interest in and to the south-east quarter of the south-east quarter of section (4) and the east one-half of the north-east quarter of the north-west quarter and the east one-half of the west one-half of the north-east quarter and the east one-half of the west one-half of the north-east quarter and the east one-half of the north-east quarter of section (9) Township 7 North Range 8 E.

To have and to hold the same unto the said Charlie W Eaton and unto his heirs and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Charlie W. Eaton that he will forever warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, JOHN J. HARRIS, of the County of San Diego, State of California, wife of the said JOHN J. HARRIS, for and in consideration of the said sum of Five Hundred Dollars money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said JOHN J. HARRIS all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
