KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS,

to me in hand paid by Ethel Davis, this receipt
of which is hereby acknowledged do hereby grant,
 bargain, sell and convey unto said Ethel Davis and unto her heirs and assigns forever, the following

lands lying in the Creek Nation Western District of the Indian Territory, to wit:

The north east quarter of the south west quarter of
the north half of the south east quarter of Section
seven township seventeen (17) north range fourteen
(14) east containing one hundred and twenty acres more or
less according to the U. S. Government survey thereof

To have and to hold the same unto the said Ethel Davis and unto her heirs and as-

signs forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

I contract and bind myself with said Ethel Davis that I will
And hereby covenant with said that will forever warrant and defend the
 title of said lands against all claims whatever persons claiming the same beyond through
me

And I, my wife of the said Wattie Grayson for and in consideration of the said sum of
 money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
