 described lot or parcel of ground lying and being situate in the Creek
 lands lying in the Western District of the Indian Territory, to wit:

all my right, title and interest in and to the south
east quarter of section fourteen (14) township eighteen
(18) north range fourteen (14) east

To have and to hold the same unto the said D.W. Jackson and J.C. McShea and unto their heirs and as-
 signs forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

 And hereby covenant with said D.W. Jackson and J.C. McShea that said lands are free from incumbrance
 that she will forever warrant and defend the
 title of said lands against all claims whatever.
