WARRANTY DEED

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That we, George W. Adams and Minnie E. Adams
 his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Eight Hundred DOLLARS,
in Land paid by John M. Holland the receipt
of which is heretofore acknowledged do hereby grant,
 bargain, sell and convey unto said John M. Holland and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following
creek nation
 lands lying in the Western Western District of the Indian Territory, to wit:

Lot 21 and Block 15 fifteen situated in the
Original town of Tulsa D.C. according to the amended
plat now on file

To have and to hold the same unto the said John M. Holland and unto his heirs and as-
 signs forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said John M. Holland that we will forever warrant and defend the
 title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Minnie E. Adams wife of the said George W. Adams for and in consideration of the said sum of
 money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said John M. Holland all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
