WARRANTY DEED

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That we, J. L. Harnage and Veronica Harnage
 his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of One DOLLARS,
and other good and valuable considerations

do hereby grant,
 bargain, sell and convey unto said W. A. Cook and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following
 lands lying in the Breck Nation Western District of the Indian Territory, to wit:

Lots 11 and 12 Block 10 in the Second Lindsey Addition
to Tulsa Indian Territory as per plat executed
by J. H. Patton

To have and to hold the same unto the said W. A. Cook in trust and unto his heirs and as-
 signs forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said W. A. Cook that he will forever warrant and defend the
 title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Veronica Harnage wife of the said J. L. Harnage for and in consideration of the said sum of
 money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said W. A. Cook all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
