## WARRANTY DEED

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That we, Alice Futrell and Frank Futrell her husband  
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Six Hundred Fifty and no DOLLARS,  
the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged

do hereby grant,  
bargain, sell and convey unto said A. M. Turner and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following

lands lying in the Creek Nation Western District of the Indian Territory, to wit:

The west half 1/2 of the north west ten (10) acres  
of Lot three (3) in Section Three (3) Township (19)  
North Range 12 East - containing five acres more or  
less

To have and to hold the same unto the said A. M. Turner and unto his heirs and as-  
signs forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said A. M. Turner that they will forever warrant and defend the  
title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Frank Futrell husband of the said Alice Futrell for and in consideration of the said sum of  
money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said A. M. Turner my entire all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
