WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That we L. W. Marks and Fannie E. Marks his wife
 his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of \$15,000 DOLLARS,

Fifteen Hundred Dollars to us paid by
J. W. Orr do hereby grant,
 bargain, sell and convey unto said J. W. Orr and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following

lands lying in the Western District of the Indian Territory, to wit: Southeast 1/4 of South
west 1/4 of North west 1/4 of section twenty seven, township sixteen
range twenty-three and the south 1/2 of Southeast 1/4 of North west 1/4
and Northeast 1/4 of Southeast 1/4 of North west 1/4, Northeast 1/4 of
Northeast 1/4 of Northeast 1/4 and Southeast 1/4 of North west 1/4 of
North west 1/4 and east 1/2 of South west 1/4 of North west 1/4 and South
west 1/4 of South west 1/4 of North west 1/4 and Northwest 1/4 of South west 1/4 of North west 1/4
 To have and to hold the same unto the said J. W. Orr and unto his heirs and as-

signs forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said J. W. Orr that we will forever warrant and defend the
 title of said lands against all ^{lawful} claims whatever.

And I, Fannie E. Marks, wife of the said L. W. Marks for and in consideration of the said sum of
 money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said J. W. Orr all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
