## WARRANTY DEED

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That we John C Mitchell and Alice M. Mitchell  
 his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of One Hundred Ten and no/100 DOLLARS,  
the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged

do hereby grant,  
 bargain, sell and convey unto said E. L. Conner and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following  
 lands lying in the town of west Tulsa Creek Nation Western District of the Indian Territory, to wit:

all of lots numbered thirteen (13) and fourteen  
(14) Block numbered nineteen (19) situated in  
the town of west Tulsa Creek Nation Indian  
Territory according to the recorded plat thereof

To have and to hold the same unto the said E. L. Conner and unto his heirs and as-  
 signs forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said E. L. Conner that we will forever warrant and defend the  
 title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Alice M. Mitchell wife of the said John C. Mitchell for and in consideration of the said sum of  
 money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said E. L. Conner all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
