WARRANTY DEED

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS,

That we E. W. Kimbly and Mellie Kimbly
 his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of One Hundred and Twenty DOLLARS,

do hereby grant,
 bargain, sell and convey unto said W. B. Blackwell and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following
 lands lying in the Town of Jenks Western District of the Indian Territory, to wit:
Lot number thirteen (13) in block eighteen (18)
according to plat filed thereof

To have and to hold the same unto the said W. B. Blackwell and unto his heirs and as-
 signs forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant S with said E. W. Kimbly that he will forever warrant and defend the
 title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I Mellie Kimbly, wife of the said E. W. Kimbly for and in consideration of the said sum of
 money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said W. B. Blackwell all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
