the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged in full.

do hereby grant,
 bargain, sell and convey unto said Jake Hashaw and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following
 lands lying in the Creek Nation Western District of the Indian Territory, to wit:
Lots seventeen & eighteen (17 & 18) Block Thirteen (13)
Dynch & Forey the addition to Tulsa, Ind. Ter.

To have and to hold the same unto the said Jake Hashaw and unto his heirs and as-
 signs forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant s with said Jake Hashaw that they will forever warrant and defend the
 title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Jennie Forey the, wife of the said Jay Forey the for and in consideration of the said sum of
 money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Jake Hashaw my all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
