WARRANTY DEED

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That we, Annie C Archer and a single woman
 his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Three Thousand (\$3000) DOLLARS,
 to her in land paid by Maryne H. Macbray the
 receipt whereof is hereby confessed and acknowledged do hereby grant,
 bargain, sell and convey unto said Maryne H. Macbray and unto her heirs and assigns forever, the following
 lands lying in the Town of North Tulsa 28th Western District of the Indian Territory, to wit:

Lot 1, numbered one and two of Block numbered
of North Tulsa 28th, according to the official
plat thereof

To have and to hold the same unto the said Maryne H. Macbray and unto her heirs and as-
 signs forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Maryne H. Macbray that she will forever warrant and defend the
 title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Annie C Archer, wife of the said Maryne H. Macbray for and in consideration of the said sum of
 money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Maryne H. Macbray all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
