WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

 of which is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant,
 bargain, sell and convey unto said George W. Adams and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following
 lands lying in the Cherokee Nation Western District of the Indian Territory, to wit:
1/2 of SE 1/4 of NW 1/4 Sec 24 X the NW 1/4 of NW 1/4 of SE 1/4
Sec 24 X SW 1/4 of NW 1/4 of NE 1/4 Sec 24 X NE 1/4 of NE 1/4
of SW 1/4 all in Sec 24 Tp. 21 N. R. 14 E, also 1/2 of SW 1/4
of SE 1/4 NW 1/3 X NE 1/4 of SW 1/4 of SE 1/4 all in Sec 13 Tp 21 N.
R. 14 E containing 8 acres more or less
according to Government Survey.
 To have and to hold the same unto the said George W. Adams and unto his heirs and as-
 signs forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said George W. Adams that they will forever warrant and defend the
 title of said lands against all claims whatever.

 money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said _____ all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
