WARRANTY DEED

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That we, James M. Cline and Nellie Cline
 his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of One and no/100-- DOLLARS,
in hand paid by L. A. Denton the receipt of which is
herby acknowledged do hereby grant,

bargain, sell and convey unto said L. A. Denton and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following

lands lying in the city of Tulsa Western District of the Indian Territory, to wit:
lot Numbered Three (3) in Block Numbered One Hundred
Ninety Two, (192) in the City of Tulsa, Indian Territory
according to Government Plat and survey thereof. This
deed made to correct a former deed dated March 28 th,
1907, filed for record April 6 th, 1907, Book 10, Page 417

To have and to hold the same unto the said L. A. Denton and unto his heirs and as-
 signs forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said L. A. Denton that we will forever warrant and defend the
 title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Nellie Cline, wife of the said James M. Cline for and in consideration of the said sum of
 money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said L. A. Denton all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
